Here will be found information about how to report a concern and what steps will be taken following your contact.

If you are worried about a child and believe that child is in immediate danger, you must contact the police on 999.

If it is less urgent and you are worried about the welfare of a child, please use the contacts below to report your concerns. You do not need to know for certain that the child is being abused. If you have concerns, you should report them to the relevant Children's Service department. You can contact them and ask them, on the basis of the information you are giving, whether they advise that you make a formal referral. It is very helpful for them if you have as much information as possible to help them identify which child you are talking about: first and last name, date-of-birth if you have it, which school they go to, and their address if possible.
